SPECTATORS Entry £6.00 per day (£4 half day). OAP/Concessions £3.00 entry per day (£2 half day). Children under 5 years free to all sessions. Payment is required for the full day and a refund will be given on handing back of the wristband before warm up of the second session. Spectator seating is capped to 200 spectators and will be on a first come first served basis.

REFRESHMENTS An extensive selection of hot food and drinks can be purchased from the cafe located in the main reception area of the leisure centre, subject to availability.

OFFICIALS It is requested that all clubs provide at least two licensed officials for each day and session please. Complimentary lunch/tea after the first session and drinks will be provided both days.

Any club who provides 3 or more officials will receive 2 free coach passes for the weekend

MEET CONDITIONS

The competition will be held under Swim England Regulations and World Aquatic Technical Rules of Swimming at Stafford Leisure Centre.

- 25m pool, 8 lanes with anti-turbulence lane ropes.
- Electronic timing with 8-lane scoreboard is to be used in conjunction with a computerised result service.
- Backstroke ledges will be available to use at this event.
- A secondary strobe for the starting system is available.
- Results will be displayed during the meet and a full set will be published on the Stafford Apex website.

The competition is open to swimmers 9 years and over. Age is at 21st June 2025. All competitors must be registered with Swim England or their own national association as appropriate.

The Female category is for birth sex females in accordance with Swim England's Transgender and Non-Binary Competition Policy. By entering the 'Female' category, a swimmer confirms that their birth sex is female.

Individual awards for the first three places in each event in the following age groups:

- 9yrs, 10yrs, 11yrs, 12yrs, 13yrs, 14yrs, 15yrs and 16yrs/over and may be collected from the designated collection point.
- Relay Teams will gain an award for the first three places in each age group
- £50 cash award for Top Club.

The use of cameras and video recording is not permitted. This includes mobile phones with a camera facility.

All participants must observe the safety precautions in operation at Stafford Leisure Centre

Entries will be accepted in accordance with the Entry Procedures.

- All events are **HEAT DECLARED WINNER**
- Over the top starts may be used, when necessary, to maintain the scheduled timing of events.

It is the responsibility of **Team Managers** and **Coaches** to check start lists for each event to ensure that their competitors are recorded correctly and that they report to the Marshalling Stewards in time for the start of their race.

If cancellation of the event is necessary then the only claim will be the entry fees paid.

The Meet Administrator will decide anything not covered by these notes.

ENTRY PROCEDURES

- Application for entry must be correctly submitted by the specified date 26th May 2025, and on the Sports System entry file.
- Entries received without payment will not be processed.
- Entries should be made electronically using SportsSystem software, the entry pack/files can be obtained by emailing galas.staffordapex@gmail.com. It will also be available on our website www.staffordapex.com.
- Entries, summary sheets and coach pass applications should be emailed to: galas.staffordapex@gmail.com. No paper entries are accepted.
- Entry fee: £7.00 per event
- Coach Passes: £10.00 per day or £18.00 for a weekend pass.

- The date that entries are received will be classified as the entry date.
- Qualifying times will be accepted to all events.
- Entry times must not be faster than the published upper qualifying times and must have been achieved since 1st April 2024.
- If an individual event is oversubscribed, entries will be accepted on a first come first served basis.

The planned start times each day are as per the programme of events however confirmed start times for all sessions will be advised with the accepted entries.

- Entry times are to be converted to 25m pool length.
- Heats will be seeded according to submitted entry times.
- Poolside entries will not be accepted.
- Coaches' passes <u>cannot</u> be purchased on the day of the Meet.
- Passes will be inspected each day to authorise poolside access.
- It is the responsibility of attending clubs to ensure that poolside passes are issued only to people who have an up-to-date DBS.

The competitor's club shall be responsible for:

- checking and validating the entry forms and fees
- entering the information from the entry forms into a database using a computer programme provided
- returning the entry files electronically by email to the Meet Administrator
- the entries summary form with one payment per club by email
- informing the Meet Administrator of any relevant health conditions and/or allergies.

A list of all accepted and rejected swims will be posted to the Stafford Apex website shortly after the closing date has passed. Rejected swims will be given full refunds. Once entries have been accepted, no refunds will be given unless supported by a valid doctor's certificate.

The club co-ordinator is responsible for checking the accepted entry lists posted on the Stafford Apex website and reporting any errors and discrepancies to the Meet Administrator. Known errors should be reported before the day of meet, no changes will be made on the day.
